Plan of Examination

The Civil Services Examination will consist of two successive stages.

1. Civil Services Preliminary Examination (Objective Type) for the selection of candidates for the Main Examinations and
2. Civil Services Main Examinations (Written and Interview) for the selection of candidates for the various Services and posts noted above.

Stage 1 Preliminary

Both the question papers will be of objective type (multiple choice questions).

The question papers will be set both in Hindi and English.

The course content of the Syllabi for the optional subjects will be of the degree level.

Each paper will be of two hours duration. Blind candidates will however, be allowed an extra time of twenty minutes at each paper.

The written examination will consist of the following papers:

Paper 6,7,8 & 9	any two subjects to be selected from The list of the optional subjects each Subject will have two papers.	1200 marks

Note: Candidate who have opted for Indian languages as medium for the main examinations have an option of being interviewed either in English or Same Language which they have opted for the main examination.

Minimum Educational Qualification

The candidate must hold a degree of any of Universities incorporated by an Act of the Central or State Legislature in India or other Educational institutions established by an Act of Parliament or declared to be deemed as a University Under section 3 of the University Grant Commission Act, 1956, or Possess an equivalent qualification.

Age Limits

1. A candidate must have attained the age of 21 years and must not have attained the age of 30 years on 1st August, of that year.i.e., he must have been born not earlier than 2nd August that year. And not later than 1st August of that year.
2. The upper age limit prescribed above will be relaxable.
